Things to know before you come to camp:

1. **All electronic devices will be confiscated.** Campers are encouraged to leave them at home.
2. **Tank tops, Tube tops, Halter tops, spaghetti straps, short shorts, Bikinis etc. are prohibited.** Students will be asked to change clothes before leaving their cabin in the morning if their clothing is deemed inappropriate by their counselor.
3. **Cabin assignments are made prior to camp, and are nonnegotiable.** Any special arrangements must be made through the director prior to the early Registration date of June 1.
4. **Scholarships are available.** If you are in need of financial assistance to attend camp please contact the director for a scholarship application. Scholarships are assigned based on need and on a first come first serve basis. Campers will not be admitted without payment or accepted scholarship application.

BURNT CABIN CHRISTIAN CAMP The purpose and aim of the Burnt Cabin Christian Camp is to make the camp a center for spiritual training; a facility where youth may receive a deeper consciousness of God in their personal lives. The camp offers activities to help our youth gain knowledge and develop attitudes that will result in decisions to submit themselves to the Lord and live according to His teaching. We promote appreciation for spiritual values and good morals, encourage Christian ideals, and the forming of genuine Christian friendships.

YOU'RE INVITED Burnt Cabin Christian Camp admits children of any race, color, or national and ethnic origin to all rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally available to campers. Rules of acceptance and participation in the program are the same for everyone. Week camp sessions are open for those children ages 9 through Sr. High. Mini Camp is open to ages

COST OF CAMP The basic cost for a week of camp is \$205.00 per full week. The fee includes canteen (drinks and snacks), and helps pay for lodging, meals, daily swimming, t-shirt, and camper accident insurance.

SAFETY FIRST Burnt Cabin Christian Camp conducts all events under the supervision of adults, with the safety of our campers in mind. A certified lifeguard will be present during swimming. When accidents or illness occur, the camper will be attended by a nurse. If needed, a hospital is near-by. Burnt Cabin carries insurance which will cover the cost of treatment of bodily injuries not covered by or in the absence of other medical insurance on the camper (illness is not covered).

PHONE CALLS Calls home are allowed only for emergency situations. This policy is necessary to prevent "have to call home" epidemics.

PREPARING FOR CAMP All camps will be open for registration from 2:00- 4:00 p.m. (Do not arrive before 2:00pm) on Sunday afternoon. An evening meal will be served on the day of registration.

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

- Your Bible
- Clothing (Plan to dress modestly, in a way that you believe is pleasing to God.)
- Swimsuit (No Bikinis) and cover-up
- Bedding for twin size bed or sleeping bag

- Toiletries, including soap
- Flashlight
- Sunscreen, not oil based
- Insect repellent
- Notebook, pencils

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- CELL PHONES (All phones will be taken on Sunday and given back to the campers on Friday night at bedtime.)

- Valuables (Money, all electronics) • Knives • Fireworks • Tobacco
- Pornographic materials • Alcohol
- Anything that is unsuitable for Christian conduct.
